


UNLEASH THE DOUBLE PEDAL

Double pedal quarter-note triplet techniques

Here we're unleashing the double pedal to create an intense sound used by rock drummers from Gregg Bisonnette to A7X's The Rev. Let's begin with the basic principle which can be seen in Example 1 where the right hand is playing quarter-notes while the feet fill in the remaining eighth-note triplets.

The next step sets the

rhythmic scene for our final application. Here, while the right hand plays a shuffle rhythm, the left hand plays quarter-note triplets while the right foot fills in the spaces. Finally in Example 3 we squeeze the left foot into the equation to play nine evenly spaced notes where we previously had six. If it sounds confusing, don't worry - it's easier to play than describe! **R**
